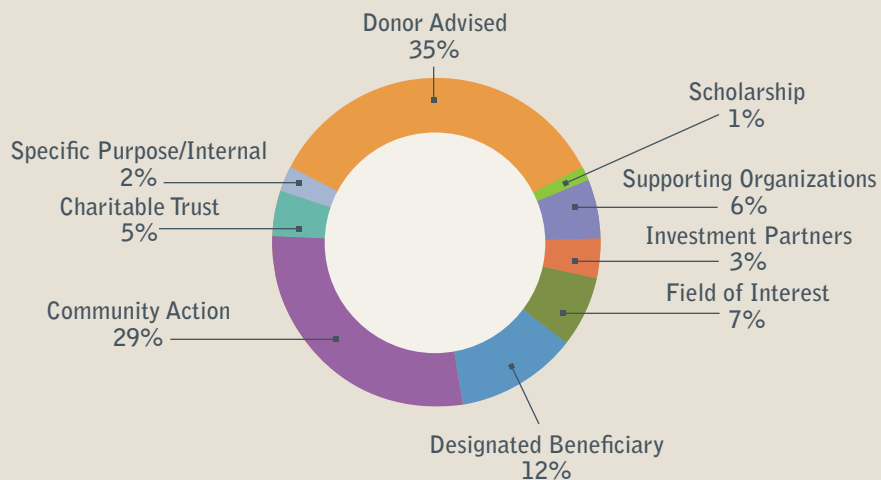

And as with all our efforts, we do not act alone, but in partnership with the business community, public institutions, nonprofit organizations, and other foundations.

We also facilitate the philanthropy of hundreds of individuals, families, and organizations whose funds and grants reflect a multiplicity of interests and concerns. More than 4,500 grants are made annually from these funds, a testament to the important role philanthropy plays in strengthening community. This year's supplement, "Minnesotans Making a Difference", lists charitable funds created by individuals, families, and businesses and some of the organizations that received grants from those funds. We think you will be impressed by the variety of ways in which Minnesotans are making a difference through the Foundation.

# 2007–08 Year in Review

## Growing Philanthropy

- **90 new funds** were established by individuals, families, businesses and nonprofits. Of these, **46 Donor Advised Funds and two Signature Funds** (Donor Advised Funds of \$1 million or more) were established. To date, the Foundation manages more than 1,000 funds.
- **Ten individuals and families became Community Builders** by providing for the Foundation in their estate plans. The Community Builders program now has **267 members**.
- **Three agencies joined our investment partnership**, including East Africa Medical Assistance Foundation, Interfaith Outreach and Community Partners, and Loaves & Fishes.

## Investing in the Community

- The Foundation awarded **\$49.5 million in total grants**. Of these grants, Donor Advisors recommended 4,650 individual grants totaling more than \$33.4 million to causes locally and around the world.
- **Community grants totaling \$4.9 million were awarded to 53 organizations** supporting affordable housing, economic opportunity, educational achievement, and the health and well-being of children, youth and families.
- **Two Requests for Proposals were issued, resulting in more than \$168,000 granted** to award camp scholarships to low-income youth and provide services for blind and visually-impaired Minnesotans.

## Donor and Client Commitment

- The Foundation continually works to improve **interactive services**, and is converting our website and data systems to better serve our constituents.
- A **Donor Advisor Committee** has been established to provide feedback and help shape our quality services to donors.
- The Foundation continues to provide **services to help private, corporate, and family foundations** develop funding guidelines, evaluate proposals, and distribute grants. New clients this year include: Minnesota MusiCares, the Monitors, and MTS Systems.

## Advocacy and Initiatives

**Minnesota Meeting.** The 2007–08 series, A Blueprint for Action, focused on three key issues facing Minnesotans: homelessness, youth violence and immigration. Each meeting brought 600–800 community members together to discuss specific strategies to address these critical issues, while several Greater Minnesota communities participated through live video conferences and local discussions. **Destination 2010.** Approximately 210 students in 41 high schools in the Minneapolis and St. Paul school districts continue to participate in Destination 2010, a student achievement and scholarship initiative of the Foundation. The focus over the next few years will be to help the students graduate from high school and prepare for and succeed at higher education. **All-Day Kindergarten.** The Foundation advocates for state funding for early childhood education and All-Day Kindergarten in Minnesota. These efforts helped ensure passage of \$32.5 million in the 2007 Legislative session to expand All-Day Kindergarten. The Foundation is currently collaborating with other funders to implement a statewide business plan for early childhood education.

## Community Partnerships

### **Youth Violence Prevention Task Force.**

Co-chaired by Karen Kelley-Ariwoola, vice president of Community Philanthropy, the task force launched a long-term action plan to reduce and prevent violence among young people. Many of the plan's 34 action items require the active involvement and coordination of government, community, faith, business and neighborhood partners, and the Minneapolis Foundation has set aside \$500,000 to support these efforts.

### **Minnesota Helps – Bridge Disaster Fund™.**

The public responded to the I-35W bridge collapse with generous offers of support. In response, the Minnesota Helps – Bridge Disaster Fund™ was formed (with seed funding from local foundations) to collect contributions and distribute them to the survivors, rescuers, and families affected. More than \$1.2 million was collected and granted to help survivors and families cope with immediate and short-term needs. **The Digital Inclusion Fund.** In 2007, \$200,000 was distributed to nine organizations that administer technology literacy programs to bridge the digital divide for people with disabilities, low incomes, people of color, immigrants and refugees, seniors, and other new technology users. The Foundation administers the fund, which was established as part of a Community Benefits Agreement between the City of Minneapolis and U.S. Internet Wireless.

**Minnesota Dream Fund.** The Foundation collaborates with other local foundations to support equal opportunity in education and employment for women and people of color through the Minnesota Dream Fund. Created in response to a Ford Foundation grant to help end the need for affirmative action by the year 2030, the fund awarded \$320,000 for two major projects in 2007. # Community Grants

# Minnesotans Making a Difference

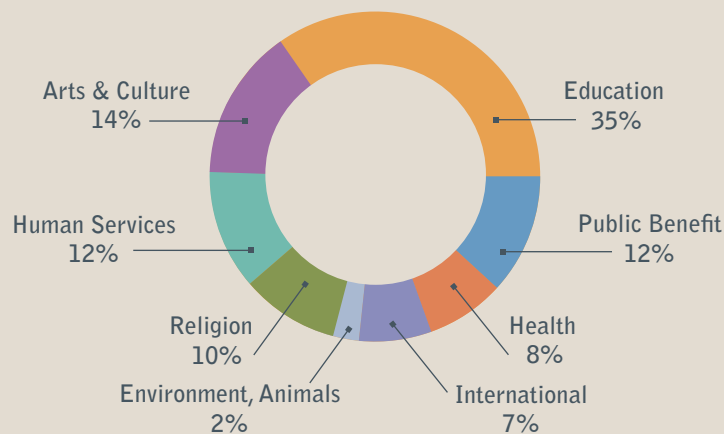
