Hope is essential.



Funding will be awarded to organizations working to build a more sustainable economic landscape in which communities can thrive, and individuals have greater economic mobility.

Small- to Medium-Sized Nonprofits with a track record of demonstrated success in and focus on:


- Advancing structural and systems change through civic participation, community organizing, and policy advocacy.
- Investing in economic systems and practices that support economic mobility, close wealth gaps, and stabilize communities.

Nonprofit Intermediaries that have demonstrated experience providing capacity building services to small- to medium-sized nonprofits focused on economic mobility and small businesses.



PRIORITY FOR **FUNDING**

- Organizations based in and serving Minneapolis and inner-ring suburbs
- Organizations that foster economic mobility by supporting key commercial corridors
- Organizational capacity




HOW TO APPLY

- You need to register yourself and your organization in our portal.
- Registration is a two-step process. After creating your account, there is a follow-up email to connect yourself to your organization.






HOW TO UPLOAD DOCUMENTS

Instructions for Templates: Please download the templates to your laptop/desktop and save them under your Orgs Name_Document Type. Once completed, please save the templates as PDFs and upload them to the details section in the application.

You can locate the required templates in three locations:

- The preview document
- The details section of the application
- The Proposed Work section of the application


